The Chairman welcomed those in attendance, stating that the purpose of this meeting was to conduct two separate Public Hearings, the first being to receive comments upon the Proposed County Operating Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2019, and the second to receive comments upon the proposed County tax levies for Calendar Year 2018.

Agenda Item 3. PUBLIC HEARING – PROPOSED BUDGET FY 2019

Chairman Hodges opened the public hearing, calling speakers in order of appearance on the public hearing sign up sheet.

1. Bill Doyle, representing Rappahannock Community College, expressed the importance of what RCC offers to our community and stated their request for additional monies this fiscal year.

2. Kathy Vesley, representing Bay Aging, explained the services her organization provides our community and expressed the importance of those services. She stated their request of additional monies.
3. Ken Polluck, representing Bay Transit, explained the services his organization provides our community and why they are requesting additional monies this fiscal year.
4. Ann Kloeckner, representing Legal Aid, noted the services her organization provides our community and the importance of those services. They are requesting additional monies this fiscal year.
5. Timothy Dice, representing Arts Alive, noted programs they provide our community and thanked the Board for their continued support.
6. Michele Grant, speaking in regards to Arts Alive, noted her positive experience with the programs they offer and asked for continued support of the organization.
7. Audrey Mitchell, representing the Pamunkey Regional Library, noted they had not requested additional funding from the Board in many years, but would like to now request additional monies.
8. Beth Dandridge, of the 2nd District, stated discrepancies in the proposed budget and that she is opposed to the adding of the assessor position and a new fire house. She also noted supporting merit-based raises.
9. Charles Piersa, of the 2nd District, stated he supported the hiring of paid fire and ems staff and complimented Mrs. Tassinari on a well put together proposed budget.
10. Don and Jeanette Wagner entered their comments prior to the meeting stating they supported the proposed budget.
11. Debra Marcum entered her comments prior to the meeting stating her support for increases in salary for teachers.
