

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON  
STATE ROUTE 682 (TIDY CAT ROAD) AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to Section 33.1-151 of the Code of Virginia, notice is hereby given that the King William County Board of Supervisors intends to abandon State Route 682 (Tidy Cat Road) in its entirety, from the intersection with State Route 613 (Dunluce Road) to the terminus of right of way, a distance of approximately 0.14 miles and will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 19, 2014 at 7:30 pm, or as soon thereafter, in the Board Meeting Room, located in the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia, to receive public comment on such abandonment.

The public is invited to attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed intention to abandon. Information on the proposed abandonment of State Route 682 (Tidy Cat Road), including a plan depicting the abandonment, can be inspected at the King William County Administration office, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA 23086 between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday.
