CUP-05-14: (Applicant, Bardon, Inc.), requests a conditional use permit to allow for excavation, extraction, processing and removal of sand or gravel. The request concerns an approximate 20-acre portion of a property known as Tax Map 1-1, a 437-acre parcel owned by Earth Materials of Virginia, LLC. The property has a physical address of 1566 McKendree Lane, Aylett VA 23009 and is located on McKendree Lane (private road) approximately 1 mile north of the intersection of W. River Road (Rt 600) and McKendree Lane (private road). The affected property is zoned A-C Agricultural Conservation. The Board will consider conditions imposing certain requirements on the proposed use in addition to those required by the zoning ordinance generally.

CUP-06-14: (Owner, King William County Board of Supervisors), requests a conditional use permit to allow for a 199' tall telecommunications tower located on property known as Tax Map 37-102, a 195-acre parcel with an address of 351 Courthouse Lane, King William VA 23086, located approximately ¼ mile east of the intersection of Horse Landing Road (Rt 619) and Courthouse Lane (Rt 1301). The affected property is zoned A-C, Agricultural Conservation. The Board will consider conditions imposing certain requirements on the proposed use in addition to those required by the zoning ordinance generally.
