

**KING WILLIAM COUNTY
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
BUILDING FEE INCREASES**

The Board of Supervisors of King William County, Virginia will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, June 22, 2015 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the public may be heard, in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, Virginia to receive public comment and consider adoption of the following matter:

Ordinance 15-08: pursuant to the authority granted by VA Code §36-105 the King William County Board of Supervisors intends to repeal King William County Code Chapter 14 *Buildings and Building Regulations* Sections 14-51 *Minimum Permit Fee*, 14-52 *Building fees*, 14-53 *Commercial structures building permit fees*, 14-54 *Industrial structures permit fees*, 14-55 *Fee for removal of building or structure*, 14-56 *Fee for demolition*, 14-57 *Fee for display structure permit*, 14-58 *Commencing construction prior to approval of application; penalty*, 14-59 *Requesting inspection prematurely; fee*, 14-61 *Plan review fees*, 14-62 *Temporary certificates* and adopt Sec. 14-51.1 *Fee Schedule* to provide for a Building fee schedule which shall be adopted from time to time by the Board of Supervisors by resolution and in addition to adopt a resolution establishing both new and increased fees for administration of the Uniform Statewide Building Code.

The full ordinance, resolution and fee schedules, including proposed increased fees, may be viewed in the Office of the County Administrator at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA, during regular business hours. All adopted fees shall be effective July 1st 2015. All interested persons may appear and present their views at the above time and place. Comments received by 12:00 noon on the day of the hearing will be distributed to Board members and made a part of the public record.
